Please read through the following list before you agree to be a chaperone for your group.

## Chaperone Responsibilities

- Be helpful and courteous to other groups, your Director, the *Dance the Magic* staff and Disney cast members
- Keep a list of your dancers with you at all times
- Check in your dancers at rehearsal and upon arrival backstage at the Disneyland® Resort
- Report to your Dance the Magic staff when your group is all together upon arrival in the park
- Be sure your dancers are ready for their group picture at their designated time
- *Disney and Dance the Magic* have **very high standards**. Please be sure your costumes, shoes, hair and make-up are in excellent condition and appropriate for a Disney audience.
- Take dancers to the restroom, if needed. Remind them to go **before** call times!
- Stay with your dancers backstage before and after their performances until released to their parents
- You will not walk in the parade- you will be released into the park several minutes before step-off to enjoy your group coming down Main Street, U.S.A. along with the other Disney guests!
- After the parade, you will meet your Disney stage manager and be brought to the backstage area to help change your dancers into street clothes
- Be sure you have collected all your studios' belongings when you leave the dressing and rehearsal areas
- Please ask your dancers to clean up after themselves while backstage
- Stay with your dancers until they have all been released to their parents
- Be **enthusiastic** and have a **positive attitude**
- *Most of all...have fun and enjoy your Dance the Magic experience at Disneyland®!*
